

StreetSquash's College Access, Success, & Alumni Support (CASAS) team provides wide ranging programs preparing students starting in 9th grade for college and the application process with weekly college prep classes, college trips, ACT tutoring, college guidance, application help, and much more.

Outcome

I wore many different hats to facilitate and plan the different program offerings from CASAS

• College Guidance Counselor

O Counseled a cohort of half of our seniors through the college application process, including researching schools, filling in application documents, writing essays, organizing and submitting financial aid documents and applications, finding and completing scholarship applications, communicating with families and school admissions officers

• College Prep Teacher

Taught College prep curriculum to 9th, 10th, and 11th grade students with increasing levels of depth in preparing them for college application process teaching the skills and tools necessary to be successful both in and post college. Wrote lesson plans and worked with team to form the syllabi and learning goals.

• ACT Math Teacher

O Create Math curriculum to prepare 11th graders for the ACT. Teach math curriculum multiple times a week to entire 11th grade in small groups balancing group teaching and individual instruction in an attempt to improve each individual's ACT Math score.

• College Prep Trips

O Planned and facilitated multiple college prep trips to familiarize 10th and 11th graders with different colleges and universities. Coordinated with admissions and diversity offices on campus to plan trip as well as communicated with students guardians.

• Post High School Non College Options

O Fostered relationships with certificate programs and vocational schools to connect our non college bound students with.

I worked in multiple roles to help students along the pipeline to either college or an alternate program that will eventually lead them to a career and financial sustainability. Throughout the process it was vital to cultivate relationships based on trust to be able to communicate effectively, help the students, and have them listen to me.
